Anna

and Testament of me Anna Butcher of Milton wills  
I desire first I desire that all my just debts be  
fully paid by the Executors of the said my will also  
I give unto my Brother Joah Butcher and my  
William Butcher their Executors and assigns all  
and singular my Money and Securities for Money  
and all other my personal Estate upon trust that  
they my said Trustees do pay the annual interest  
or profits thereof unto my Sister Elizabeth Butcher  
Spinster for and during the term of her natural life  
and from and immediately after her decease I do  
give and bequeath all and singular my said ready  
money and Securities for money and all other my  
personal Estate unto my Nephews and Nieces to  
Edward of my Brother Joah Butcher and Sarah  
Cook as shall be living share and share alike  
also I give and devise unto my said Sister Elizabeth  
Butcher all that my Pleasure Garden and a plot of  
land situate in Milton aforesaid and  
now in my possession to hold to her for the term  
of her natural life and from and immediately after  
the determination of that Estate I do give and  
devise all and singular my said Pleasure Garden  
and Pleasure unto my said Brother Joah  
Joah Butcher his heirs and assigns for ever also  
I give unto my said Trustees Ten pounds apiece  
as a small acknowledgment of the trusts of the  
my will and do hereby appoint them my Trustees  
and Executors thereof and do declare this to be and a  
contain my last will and Testament in witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first  
day of May 1806 — Anna Butcher Signed

was proved at London the  
sixth day of April in the Year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and nine before the  
Right Honourable Sir William Wynne Knight & Joah  
Murray Knight Doctor of Laws Master Keeper of

Commissary of the Prerogative Court of Canterbury  
lawfully constituted by the letters of William Butler  
the Brother of the deceased and one of the Executors  
named in the said will to whom admou was granted

I Mary Beaden of Gosport in the County of a  
Southampton widow of Robert Beaden described in  
the last granted will on the will Robert Beaden

do make public and declare my last will and  
testament in manner following that is to say I do  
give and bequeath all my wearing apparel of  
every description unto my late sister Anne  
Burt widow and the wife of John Taylor of  
Gosport aforesaid woman and abbot, Henry Spenser  
equally to be divided between them share and share  
alike also I give and bequeath my silver  
Lever six <sup>two</sup> Spoon two silver Table Spoons silver  
Cass Spoon and silver Sugar Tongs unto my daughter  
Elizabeth Beaden and do direct the same to be  
delivered by my Executors hereafter named unto  
my said daughter Elizabeth on her attaining the  
age of twenty one years or on the day of her  
marriage whiche ever may first happen and I give  
and bequeath all my household Goods and furniture  
plate except what I have already disposed of  
Anna Mowico's charities for money and all my  
personal Estate and Effects as well such as I now  
have or any which may hereafter devolve to me  
on any event or contingency whatsoever unto  
George Curme of Gosport aforesaid Robert and George  
Hooper the elder of the same place Butler the  
Executors and administrators upon trust that they  
and the Survivor of them his Executors or assigns  
do and shall immediately after my decease by  
public Auction or private contract or partly by  
public Auction and partly by private contract  
sell and dispose of such part of my said personal Estate  
and Effects as are not monies and the monies  
arising by or from such sale or sales do and  
shall lay out and invest the same together with all
