 shall be raised and paid to Mistris Alice George, which I give her as a further
 legacy, And this I declare to be parte of my will, My hand and seale witness
 the same this third day of March the thysand six hundred forty five. the mark

Memorandum the Testator at the tyme of makinge this Woditill, did expresse
 direct and declare, that his Executors should seale and consume to Eoff Stallingo
 a lease which was drawne and agreed upon betwene them for certayne garden

 pounds, which is a great deale more then my Estate will amount to satisfie
 And for and towards the payment and satisfaction of the said Debt, I doe
 give and bequeath, all my goodes chattels righte creditts and Estate whatsover
 unto the said Michaell Warren to his owne proper use, And I doe make
 and ordaine the said Michaell Warren sole Executor of this my last will and
 Testament. In witness whereof hereto, I the said Testator have sett my hand
