# In the Name of God Amen

I Cornelius Butcher of the parish of St Leonard Shoreditch  
in the County of Middlesex being in perfect health of body and sound  
of mind and memory Thanks be to Almighty God for the same  
knowing the frailty of this mortal life the certainty of death the  
uncertainty of the time when I do make and Ordaine this my last will  
and Testament Inprimis I Commit my spirit to God who gave it  
my body to the ground in sure and certain hopes of a blessed  
Resurrection to be interred at the discretion of my Executor hereunder  
named and of the goods of this world which it has pleased God  
to bestow on me I bequeath as following viz: To my nephew/Phelip  
Butcher To my nephew James Stone and to my nephew Cornelius  
Stone each one quinea to be paid by my Executor at a time as she  
shall think fit after my decease And lastly I will and Ordaine my  
loving wife Mary Butcher my sole Executor to have and enjoy all  
and every of my household goods plate wearing Apparel &c that  
shall be found to belong to me and likewise my moiety of the Stocks  
of Goods Debts out of which is betwixt me and Edward Enock as by  
our Articles of Copartnership will by our Books appear That is after  
all our Debts are comp taken up at Interest shall be discounted or paid  
Then I say my moiety of the great proceeds my said Executor to  
have and enjoy to and for her own use and at her own disposal  
as she my said Executor shall think fit and lastly That she my said  
Executor shall pay all my Debt funeral charge &c And this I do  
allow to be my last will and Testament hereby revoking disallowing  
and making void all former wills by me heretofore made either by  
word or Writing In witness whereof I do sign this with my own hand  
This sixth day of October Anno Domini 1718. Cornelius Butcher

19. October 1719 Which day

Appeared personally Atkinson Bugby of the parish  
of St Dunstons Pauls in the City of London Merchant and Deacon  
of the same parish Gent and being severally sworn upon the Holy  
Evangelists to swear and depose the Truth did swear and depose as  
followeth viz: That they severally were intimate and well acquainted  
with Cornelius Butcher late of St Leonard Shoreditch in the County of  
Middlesex deceased for the space of Twenty years before his death and  
in that time have frequently seen him write and were very well  
acquainted with his Character and manner of handwriting and having  
now perused the last will and Testament of the said deceased hereunto  
annexed do verily believe in their Consciences that the same is totally  
wrote and subscribed by and with the proper handwriting of the said

Martha Boheme of the parish of St Mary Magdalens Old fish street  
London a Widow being very weak in body but praised be God of sound  
mind and memory do make this my last will and Testament in manner  
following to wit I humbly resigne my Soul into the hands of  
Almighty God my Creator hoping through the merits of my blessed  
Saviour and Redeemer Jesus Christ to obtain His pardon of all my  
Sins and to inherit Eternal life My body I Commit to the Earth to  
be privately interred and as to all my worldly goods I give and dispose  
thereof as followeth to wit I give and bequeath unto my Granddaughter  
Martha Boheme the sum of One hundred and Twenty pounds to be  
paid out for her support and maintenance by my Executor hereafter  
named in such manner as he shall think fit Item I give unto my son  
John Boheme five pounds and unto my son Gouldsmith Boheme five  
pounds Item I give unto my brother Richard Chedham two shillings to  
be paid unto him weekly during his life by my said Executor Item I  
give unto my said Executor five pounds as a small acknowledgement  
for his trouble in the Execution of this my will Item all the Rest and residue  
of my Estate whatsoever after all just debts are satisfied and paid I give  
and bequeath unto my son August Boheme and my said Granddaughter  
Martha Boheme share and share alike to be paid to them for  
their support and maintenance by my said Executor in such manner as he  
shall think fit and that the residue of my Estate may the sooner appear  
I desire my said Executor to sell and dispose of all my household goods  
and to collect in the debts due to my Estate with all convenient speed And  
I do hereby constitute and appoint my loving brother Mr George  
Boheme sole Executor of this my last will and Testament In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixteenth day of  
September 1719. Martha Boheme. Signed sealed published and declared  
by the said Martha Boheme for and as her last will and Testament in  
the presence of Eliz. Boheme. Jo. Cheeke.
