# In the name of God Amen

the six and  
twentieth day of August Anno Dni one thousand six hundred and two, and in the  
fourth and fortieth yere of the raigne of our soueraigne Lady Elizabeth by the grace  
of god Queen of England France and Ireland defendour of the faith, et c. Andronic  
Beame Citizen and greator of London, now dwellinge in the parish of S. Martini  
Eborac in Southwarke in the County of Surrey, beinge sit in body but sounde  
in mynde, and of good and perfect remembrance, laude and prayse be to almighty  
God, doe ordaine and make this my wille last will and testament, in manner and forme  
followinge; that is to saye; firste and principally I give and bequeath my soule into the  
handes of almighty god, trustinge to be saved through the onely merits of Ihesus xpus  
and his precious blode shedding, my body to be decently broughte to Christian buriall  
at the discretion of my Executor hereunder named, And as touching the disposition of  
of those temporall goodes, wherewith god of his goodnes hath blessed me, first I give and  
bequeath unto my sister Elizabeth, Zymaden Ten poundes of lawfull English money;  
And to my Aunt Merye Fuller I give and bequeath the somme of fiftie shillings of  
like money, to be severally payde to them within one yere next after my deceasse  
quarterly by even portions, Item I give bequeath to my wiffes sonne Daniel Clarke  
the somme of ten poundes of lawfull English money to be payde unto him, at the  
accomplishment of his age of twentie and one yeres, Item for the speciall trust and  
confidence that I have and repose in my good frendes maister John Tyze and  
Bartholomew Brickwoode my two Executors hereunder named, I give to them the  
same John and Bartholomew: To the wile hereunder mentoned, the somme of twentie  
poundes of lawfull money of Englande, to be payde unto them their Executors or adminis-  
trators within two monthes next after my deceasse, wherof somme of money I will and  
desire that they shall putt forth or disburse, oppon god service from tyme to tyme, to  
the moste benefit and profit that they with god assistance shall or maye be able, And  
that the yerelie profit and commodity wherof shall arise, or redome thereof shall be  
by them with other of the assistance of the church within the parish afore-  
saide, be distributed unto and amongst the poore of the same libertie, wherof moste neede  
shalbe yerelie for evermore, charginge them as they will answer before god, to see this  
my wille herein performed carefulle, according to my saide trust; Item I give unto my  
three servants Robert Lowe, John Roberts and my maide servant Margerit, tenn  
shillings a peece. All the residue of my good chattell and rathell, movables, my debts  
if any be; beinge first payde, and my severall expenses discharged, I give and bequeath  
unto my wellbelovd child, whom I ordaine and make my full and sole Executor of this  
my last will.

my last will and testament, And I ordaine and make my saide friends maister John ...  
Josephus and maister Bartholomew Birkwood Executors of the same, And I give to ...  
either of them for their paines and travailes to be taken ab. aforesaid forty shillings a peece,  
In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hande and seal, the day and yere firste ...  
above written, in the presence of me Thomas, Sealed and delivered by the saide Thomas, as ...  
his last will and testament, in the presence of me J. Johnson Sr. Bartholomew Birkwood  
and James Peade servant to the saide Richard Johnson.

**I**n the name of God Amen the thirt and ...  
twentieth daye of Auguste, One thousand six hundred and two, I Phillip Earlande  
Citizen and Clothworker of London sit in bodie: but of good and perfect remembrance,  
thunke be to god therefore, knowing that death is certaine to all men: but the ...  
honor of death is also certaine to all men, and assuring my selfe of noe other ...  
salvation, then by and through the death and passion of Ihesus my maker and  
Redemer, I commend my soule unto him, and my bodie to the earth from whence it came,  
I charge my executor and Executors hereunder named, to see the same honestly and decently  
brought thither, And for these my moveable goods and chattels whatsoever they be of  
his goodnes hath endued me withall, I doe wholly give and bequeath the same unto Mathew  
Earland my supposed sonne, whom I doe make and appointe my whole and sole executor of ...  
this my last will and testament, my debts and funeralles duly paid and discharged, And I  
doe ordaine, nominate and appointe, to be his guardian, till it please god he come to age or  
Hamlet Battershall of London clooper, But if yt shall please god the saide Mathew ...  
Earland my supposed sonne shall departe this world before he come to lawfull age, that is  
to say, one and twentieth yeres: then my will, minde and meaninge is, that all such my goods  
chattels and all thinge unto me, at the day of the date hereof anuente or growinge, ...  
shall goe and fall due unto the poore of the parish of Saint Giles at Druplegate, ...  
whereof I am a parishioner, and to be employed for their benefit by the Collectors of  
the poore at the time of his death, And I doe nominate ordaine and constitute Exec-  
utors of this my last will and testament, my loving and good friends Robert Verolande,  
Thomas Framme Putnam Shandler and Richard Cowell Clothworker Citizens of London  
to whom for their paines herein to be taken, and to each of them I doe give and bequeath ...  
ten shillings a peece. And I doe hereby wholly revoke, disannull and make void, all  
and singular will and willy legacies and bequestes whatsoever to any man made, given  
or bequeathed, or by me made at any time sealed delivered and acknowledged, and this to  
stande and remaine for my last will and testament, I doe acknowledge allowe and confirme,  
and none other. In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hande and seal, the day and  
yere above written, and in the fourth and fortieth yere of the raigne of our soueraigne ...  
Ladie Elizabeth, by the grace of god Queene of England France and Ireland defend  
of the faith, &c. being witnesses hereunder named Phillip Earlande. Read subscribed
