of Wansworth in the County of Surry do hereby revoke all former wills & Codicils and other testamentary dispositions by me at any time or times heretofore made and declare this to be and contain my last will and Testament whereas I am entitled under a power reserved to me in and by a certain Subenture of release & bearing date or about the thirtieth fifth day of May One thousand Eight hundred and eleven and made or expressed to be made between my late father the Reverend Robert Holt Butcher decedent of the first part myself of the second part and certain other persons therein respectively named of the third and fourth parts and by means of a recovery suffered in pursuance of a Covenant contained in the same Subenture and also a declaration of uses therein also contained to appoint the manor or lordship of a certain Manor situate lying and being in the parish of Havant in the County of Hampshire with its rights royalties manors and appurtenances and also divers or certain messuages farms lands tenements and hereditaments in the same Subenture mentioned or referred to subject nevertheless and without prejudice to a life Estate therein now subsisting in my mother Ann Butcher To the use of said person or persons and for said Estate or Estates as I should think proper Herein exercise and execution of the said wills or referred to power and by virtue and in exercise and execution of all other powers and authorities enabling me in this behalf I do by this my last will and Testament in writing duly executed and attested appoint the same manor and all and singular the said messuages lands tenements and hereditaments comprized in the said wills or referred to Subenture of release and recovery (subject nevertheless and without prejudice to the life Estate therein of my said mother Ann Butcher during the continuance thereof) unto and To the use of my friends Francis Talbot of Dolles plate Drompton in the County of Middlesex Esquire and a certain William Pittbars of Upper Dunstable House Esquire in the County of Surry Esquire to be equally divided between them as Tenants in Common and their respective heirs and assigns for ever and I give and devise all my real Estates whatsoever and whatsoever and in which I have any beneficial Interest or Right of disposition whether in remainder or in possession and as well in remainder as in possession unto and to the use of the said Francis Talbot and William Pittbars their heirs assigns in equal shares as tenants in Common and not as joint tenants and I give and devise to them and their heirs and assigns all Estates held by me as mortgagor or trustee upon the same or the like trusts as I was or shall or may hold the same and I give and bequeath to my said mother Ann Butcher the Sum and a certain dividend which from and after my decease and thenceforth during the life of my said mother shall become due and payable in respect of the sum of Seven hundred and fifty pounds three per Cent Consolidated Bank Annuities now standing in my name in the books of the Governor and Company of the Bank of England and I bequeath to my said mother her life Interest and which is now already subsisting in the sum of One thousand and fifty pounds and a half per Cent Bank Annuities (late the sum of One thousand and fifty pounds four per Cent Bank Annuities and part of the property to which I became entitled from my Grandmother Elizabeth Stanton) and I direct that upon the decease of my said mother the said several sum of Seven hundred and fifty pounds three per Cent Consolidated bank annuities and One thousand and fifty pounds three and a half per Cent Bank Annuities shall go and belong and I give and bequeath the same accordingly unto my said friends Francis Talbot and William Pittbars in equal shares as Tenants in Common and their respective heirs assigns and assigns charges and chargeable nevertheless as aforesaid mentioned concerning my ordinary personal Estate except so far as relates

to the life Interest respectively of my said mother under this my will or otherwise of and
 in the said sum of seven hundred and fifty pounds and one thousand and fifty pounds
 and I give and bequeath to my Cousin Ann Pipou the wife of Major Pipou as and
 for her sole and separate use and disposal all literary books and works belonging
 to me whether printed or in manuscript and my Diamond Necklace with the ear
 rings and Diamonds ring late the property of my said Grandmother and to the said Straus
 Tattler my Gold Pearl Case and my enamelled watch with the Chain and Straps and
 other trinkets belonging thereto and the several rings respectively given to me by Mr. & Mrs.
 Barlow with the docket containing her hair and to the said Hannah Pittard
 my Pearl Spray ear rings and the ring given me by my mother and also the rings
 with hair and set round with pearls and to Isabella Straus Duke the ring with
 the Aunt Fanny's hair and bearing the Motto 'Forget me not' And as to all other
 Jewels and Trinkets belonging to me and not hereinbefore specifically bequeathed I give
 and bequeath the same unto and between my said friends Straus Tattler and Hannah
 Pittard in equal shares and to be divided between them as they may think proper
 the right of choosing to be ascertained by casting lots And as to the Rest Residue
 and Remainder of all monies belonging to me in the funds or upon securities
 or otherwise and all and every other my personal Estate and Effects of every description
 not hereinbefore specifically given and bequeathed I give and bequeath the same a
 charged and chargeable nevertheless with the payment of all debts due and owing by
 me at the time of my decease and my funeral and testamentary expenses unto the
 said Straus Tattler and Hannah Pittard in equal shares as tenants in common
 and their respective executors administrators and assigns and I hereby appoint my said mother
 Ann Pipou and the said Straus Tattler and Hannah Pittard the **Executors** of
 this my will In witness whereof I the said Straus Elizabeth Dutcher the Testatrix
 have to this my last will and Testament contained in four sheets of paper set my
 hand and seal that is to say my hand to the first three sheets thereof and my hand
 and seal to this fourth and last sheet the Twentieth day of July in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five *Frances Elyth Dutcher (Sd)*
 signed sealed published and declared by the said Straus Elizabeth Dutcher the Testatrix
 as and for her last will and Testament in the presence of us who in her presence
 at her request and in the presence of each other have hereto subscribed our names

 and Hannah Pittard Spinners the surviving Executrices to whom Admou was granted
 having been first sworn the said Straus Tattler before the Coroner's Colliery Colliery
 Curteis St of Saros and Surrogate and the said Hannah Pittard by Commission
 only to Admouster.

On the 3^d June 1831 Admou with the will annexed of the Goods Chattels and Credits

 universal legatee named in the said will having been first sworn duly to Admouster
 there not being any Executor named in the said will.
