 the parish of Studham in the County of Bedford virtually being in  
 perfect mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same do  
 make and ordaine this ad my last Will and Testament in manner and  
 forme following (that is to say) first and principally I comend my soul into the  
 hands of Almighty God trusting through the alone Meritts of my dear Saviour  
 Christ to have salvation for the same and as for those worldly Goods  
 the Lord hath lent me I give and bequeath the same as followeth Inprimis I  
 give and bequeath to my two Brothers John and George Booth to each  
 One shilling Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Anne Booth One  
 hundred pounds to be paid her by my Executor herein after named when  
 she shall arrive to the age of one and Twenty years Item I give and bequeath  
 to my loving wife Sarah Booth all the rest residue and Remainder of  
 my real or personall Estate whatsoever or wheresoever at the time of my  
 decease Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Uncle Thomas Puyon  
 of Studham in the County of Bedford the sume of five shillings who I do make  
 and ordaine my full and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testam  
 he paying all my Just debts payables and funerall Expenses and do  
 revoke and utterly make void all former Wills by me at any time made  
 as witness my hand and seal the day and year above said the mark of  
 William Booth, whose names are hereunto subscribed did see the  
 Testator set his hand and seal to these presents as witness our hands  
 George Sturges the mark of Joseph Perry.

I Edmund Butcher of the parish of Stroud in the County of Glouc Clothier being infirme of body but of a sound and perfect memory praised be the Lord for it do make and ordaine this my last Will and Testament in manner and forme following Inprimis I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it me and my body to the earth to be decently buryed by my Exstutor hereafter named and as for what worldly Goods it have pleased God to give me I give and bequeath as followeth Inprimis I give and bequeath unto my Niece Ann Doves daughter of my Brother Thomas Doves of London the summe of ten pounds and to her son James Doves the summe of ten pounds Item I give unto her sister Elizabeth Doves daughter of my aforesaid Brother Thomas the summe of thirty pounds Item I give unto my Cozen Edmund Doves Grandson of my aforesaid Brother Thomas Doves the summe of One hundred pounds all which said summes to be paid by my Exstutor Item all the rest and residue of my goods Chattells monneys and Credits of what nature or kind soever after my debts and funerall Expences are discharged and paid I give and bequeath unto my Cousen Thomas Doves of London son of my aforesaid Brother Thomas Doves whom I do nominate and appoint to be my whole and sole Exstutor of this my Will revoking all former Wills by me made In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifti day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Eighteen the mark of Edmund Butcher, sealed published and declared in the presence of Edward Aldridge Tho: Foxe day.
