Memory do give and bequeath unto my friends Mary Wofford
Widow Mr. Burwell Smith and Jane his wife William Warriner
and Mary his wife each of them a Ring of One Guinea Value all the
rest and residue of what nature soever I shall dye worth after paying
my Just debts as now stated and funeral Charges I give and bequeath
to my dear friend Mary Wofford whom I appoint my full and whole
Excutrix after paying my father Joseph Daynes One Shilling to dispose
of at her discretion as I now witness my hand the 29 day of January -
1751. Eliz^h Butcher Witness Mary Finch her mark Mary Warriner

This Will

was proved at London the seventh day of April in the
Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and fifty two before the
Honourable Robert Chapman Doctor of Laws and Surrogate of the Right
Hon^{ble} Sir George Lee Knight Doctor of Laws Attorney General
Commissary of the Prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted
by the Oath of Mary Wofford Widow the Sole Excutrix named in the
said Will to whom administration was granted of all and singular
the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased being first sworn
duly to administer the same. - 1751

Louisa Robert of the Parish of Christ Church Spittle fields
in the County of Middlesex Spinster being sick in Body but by the
Grace of God of sound mind Memory and understanding have
thought proper to cause my last Will and Testament to be
written in manner following first I commit my soul to God
my Creator through the merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour leaving
my Body to the earth in hopes of a blessed Resurrection to be
interred in decent manner at the discretion of my Cousin
Martha Etienne Widow whom I name constitute and appoint Sole
and only Excutrix of this my present Testament and after the
payment of my just debts and the charges of my funeral
shall be paid and satisfied the rest and residue of my Estate
whatsoever and whatsoever the same may consist I give and
bequeath the same totally and without any reserve or restriction
to the said Martha Etienne my Cousin for her to enjoy the
same at her Will I the said Louisa Robert the Testatrix do
declare that this present Will doth contain my last intentions
In witness whereof I have signed and sealed the same by
making my usual Mark in the presence the seventh day of
April in the year One Thousand seven hundred and fifty two
Anno Domini 1752. Louisa Robert her mark. Signed sealed published
and declared by the said Louisa Robert for her last Will and
